



## **Employment Opportunity: Postdoctoral Residency in Professional Psychology and Integrated Behavioral Health**

The 1500-hour residency program is designed to meet the one-year full-time supervised work experience required by the Oregon Board of Psychology for psychologist licensure in Oregon.

### Qualifications:

- Eligible to enter into a Psychologist Residency contract with the Oregon Board of Psychology.
- Interest in and demonstrated ability to work as part of an integrated team of healthcare professionals including medical providers, other behavioral health providers, care managers, and community partners to provide coordinated care to clients with a wide range of psychological needs.
- Training and experience delivering psychotherapeutic services to clients with complex medical issues and a wide range of behavioral health concerns.
- Ability to effectively deliver evidence-based psychotherapeutic interventions that can be applied to a wide range of clients.
- Demonstrated commitment to social justice and ability to provide culturally competent services, with an ongoing commitment to training and development in this area.
- Excellent communication skills as evidenced by the ability to establish collaborative relationships with clients and other professionals.
- Demonstrated ability to accurately document interventions, including charting on clinical services, completing written psychological reports, and other professional documentation.
- Training and experience in the areas of psychological assessment and report writing is preferred.

- Capacity to complete activities required to maintain a license or residency contract to practice in the State of Oregon in good standing.

Compensation and Benefits:

- Salary is \$49,000 per year.
